


Know Your Terms



This glossary will help you know the terms you need, not only while working towards your new adventure, but also once you are calling somewhere new, home!

Border Control	Measures taken by a country to monitor and regulate its borders controlling the movement of people, animals, and goods into and out of a country.
Citizen or National	A legally recognized subject or national of a country or commonwealth, either native or naturalized.
Customs	The official department that administers and collects duties levied by a government on imported goods.
Digital Nomad	Someone who uses technology, especially a laptop and WIFI, to work remotely from anywhere in the world.
Entrepreneur	A person who starts and/or runs a new business or organization.
Expatriate (Expat)	Someone who lives in another country by choice.
Expatriate Worker	Someone who lives and works in another country by choice, often on work sponsored permits.
Fortnight	A period of two weeks.
Hub	A city in which an airline has a major presence, often in the city in which the airline was formed. For example, Dallas is a hub for American Airlines.
Lifestyle Entrepreneur	An individual that creates a business with the purpose of altering their personal lifestyle, not for the sole purpose of making profits.
Naturalized	The process by which a foreign citizen becomes a citizen of a new country.
Online / Internet Entrepreneur	An owner, founder, or manager of an internet based business who makes money through risk and initiative.
Residency	The status of legally living and working in a country where someone was not born.
Resident	A person who legally lives in a country permanently or on a specifically-timed / long-term basis.
Virtual Community	A group of people with the same interests who share their ideas and opinions on a website.
Visa	An endorsement indicating the holder can enter, leave, stay, and possibly earn revenue for a period of time.
Work Permit	An official document giving a foreigner permission to take a job and earn income in a country.
